Process Team:

Phase 1: NIST review to assess adequacy

Phase 2: If justified, open and conduct revision

We are still in Phase 1, progressing:

- *Revision Initiation Package* produced
- Broad package review completed 24May
- USG Business Requirements Meeting 12Jul
- Impact of BRM decided, editing package now
- Management review & approval to be resumed

Recommendations from Business Requirements Meeting (1)

1. Clarify PIN & PUK text, unblock vs. reset
2. Clarify text on HW & SW Key Mgmt Keys
3. Hook for Mutual Authentication (later?)
4. CAK asym. mandatory and sym. optional
5. Add “Change Management” section
6. Improve resilience through adaptability
7. Move some Vis. Card Topo. into SP800-104

Recommendations from Business Requirements Meeting (2)

8. Revise card maintenance requirements
 1. Minimize number of in-person visits
 2. Allow maximum lifetime for each issuance
 3. Synchronize card, cert, biometric lifetimes
 4. Allow remote activation, PIN reset, updates
9. Harmonize identity source document list
