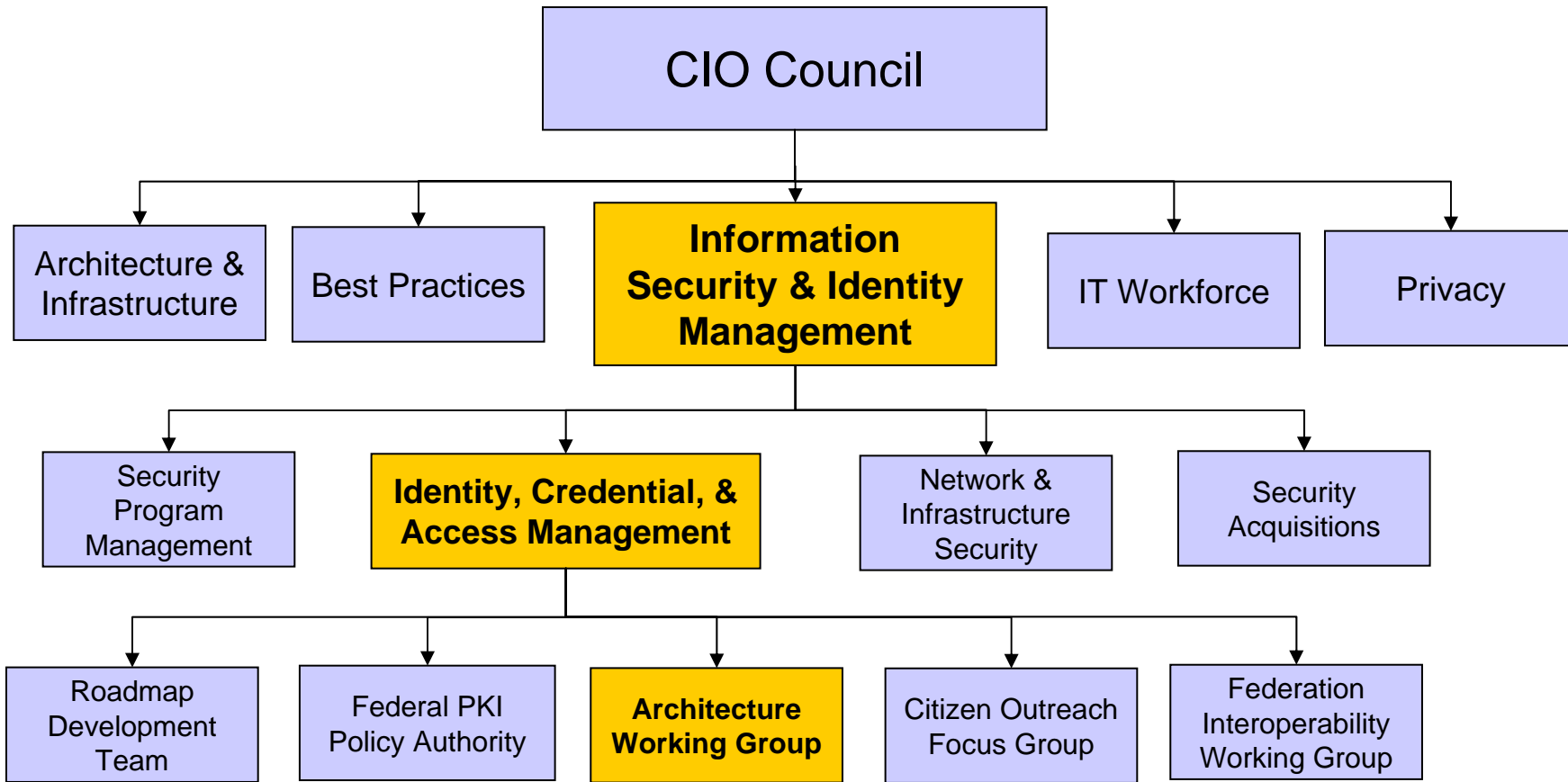

# Identity, Credential, and Access Management

## AWG Approach

- The AWG is not an open forum.
  - Subject to ICAMSC and other governance.
  - Unlike other forums since it is not under a particular charter.
- The AWG makes recommendations that go up the chain for approval (ICAMSC, ISIMC, Federal CIO Council).
  - AWG goal is to foster open communications within the group so as to provide valuable inputs/recommendations.
  - The focus is solely on recommending viable solutions.
  - The AWG is neutral, and does not endorse any solutions, vendors, or products.
  - Documents the AWG sees are not always for public consumption, so all documents are treated as privileged— for AWG use only.
